Our wines score high in James Suckling's 2019 Chile report

James Suckling, (jamessuckling.com) internationally recognized wine critic visited Chile early this year and tasted around 1200 wines for his 2019 report. We are very happy for the scores our wines received posing new challenges to our on-going commitment of crafting wines that reflect our noble soils in the Maule, Colchagua and Casablanca Valleys.















LAHUEN 2016 | 92 POINTS

This is a straightforward red with blueberry, walnut and almond aromas and flavors. Medium body, polished tannins and a subtle and delicious aftertaste. Drink now.

CA1 2016 | 90 POINTS

This rather dry and elegant Carmenere has quite a sleek palate, crisp acidity and rather dry tannins. Yet, it has a lot more life than most wines of this vintage. If the delicate blue-fruit aromas were a bit more expressive, this would rate higher. Drink or hold.

GRAN RESERVA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016 | 91 POINTS

A nice, mature Cabernet Sauvignon with fresh blackberries and a touch of smoky oak. I like the generous, moderately dry tannins that give this a firm backbone and make it food-friendly. Clean, long finish.

GRAN RESERVA CARMENERE 2017 | 91 POINTS

A full-bodied, ripe carmenere with stacks of black-fruit aromas and just a touch of smoke. The soft tannins hold all this extravagance together very nicely and the finish is long and moderately dry. Drink or hold.

GRAN RESERVA CARIGNAN 2017 | 91 POINTS

A powerful and highly structured Carignan with dark cherries and plenty of mineral power, plus crisp acidity. Drink or hold.
